Tradition, and Legends:**

"Come on, you S O B's, do you want to live forever?"

Marine Corps legend has it that this saying originated during World War I in France. During the violent fighting in Belleau Wood, Sergeant Dan Daly's platoon, part of the 6th Marines, was pinned down by intense enemy fire. The gallant Daly, already possessor of two Congressional Medals of Honor (one for heroism during the China Relief Expedition in 1900 and the other received during the Haitian Campaign of 1915), raged up and down the line trying to get his troops moving. Finally, the story goes, he yelled "Come on, you S O B's, do you want to live forever?" as he leaped out of the trench, and led his men in the attack.

Bill was born May 2, 1931 in Clarksburg, WV to Farland and Evelyn Bailey. After graduating from high school, Bill enlisted in the United States Navy, serving four years. In keeping with his desire to serve his country, he joined the United States Marine Corps in 1958.

After his military career, Bill enjoyed working in the financial industry, including IRS; Lacamas and Columbia Credit Unions; and lastly with the Vancouver School District as a security officer.

In 2002, he retired for good. He was a volunteer for the VA at the Vancouver campus. Bill was a true patriot who loved his country and the USMC. He will be missed by all who knew him.

Bill was a lifetime member of VFW Post 7824, the Marine Corp League and the Korean War Veterans. He was fully committed to the American Legion, Post 14 and the 40 ET 8 Voiture 99, where he served for over 44 and 26 years respectively. Bill is survived by his wife, Judy Bailey; son, Vince (Susan) Bailey; granddaughter, Dani; and son, Rick Edwards. He was preceded in death by his mother and father; and his wife, Janie.

Bill joined the Columbia River Detachment, Marine Corps League as a charter member in September 1992, became a life member. He served as our JrVice & Sr Vice Cmndn't from 1994-1996, was a member of the Military Order of the Devil Dogs. (Honor Society of the League.) and most recently was honored as the "Oldest Marine" present at the Celebration of our Marine Corps' 239th year on 10 November 2014

A memorial service will be held at Salmon Creek Methodist Church, 12217 NE Hwy. 99, Vancouver, WA on Thurs., Jan. 8, 2015 at 1:00 p.m., followed by a Celebration of Life at the 40 ET 8 Boxcar Room.
